

ZP - Metallised, white-voided biaxially oriented polypropylene (BOPP) film, heat sealable (nonmetallised side), high barrier, one side corona treated.



Features

- One side corona treated (outer side of the reel - metallised side)
- Heat sealable (non-metallised side)
- High light barrier
- High water vapour and aroma barrier
- High opacity

- Flexographic and rotogravure printing
- Horizontal and vertical packaging machines (HFFS-VFFS)
- Labels for PET bottles
- Printable and suitable for lamination (on metallised side)

Reel Labelling

Different films have various special surfaces; these are indicated on the reel labels.

Film Storage and Handling

Recommended processing conditions: 15-35°C, humidity below 75% RH. Before processing it is recommended to season the film in the processing conditions at temperature 20°C for a minimum of 24 hours.

In case of transporting or storing the film:

- below +15°C or above +35°C seasoning time should be extended to 48 hours;
- below + 5°C or above +40°C seasoning time should be extended to 72 hours.

Compliance with the above guarantees correct film processing.

The suitability for printing and lamination is guaranteed for 30 days from the date of production. Before the lamination process, the film must be additionally activated (metallised surface). Before the printing process, the film must be additionally activated and primer must be applied (metallised surface).
